<b>For our affiliates’ everyday business purposes—</b> information about your transactions and experiences	We have no affiliates	N/A

<b>For our affiliates to market to you</b>	We have no affiliates	N/A

How do we protect your personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How do we collect your personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open an account or deposit money</li> </ul>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
<b>Non-affiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
<b>Joint marketing</b>	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
